Indiana Dairy Producers is pleased to announce that it will be awarding a \$1000 scholarship for post-secondary education to a deserving student. The scholarship will be awarded to the successful applicant after demonstration that they are enrolled and attending a post-secondary educational institution in the fall of 2026. Students planning to attend a trade school, technical school, community college, or university are all encouraged to apply.

Eligibility

1. Student plans to attend a trade school, technical school, community college, or university for fall 2026.
2. Student must be in their final year of High School now, or have already graduated from High School and will be attending a post-secondary institution in first, second, or third year for the 2026-2027 school year.
3. Student must be a current-dues paying member of Indiana Dairy Producers or;
4. Student must have a spouse, parent, grandparent, or legal guardian who is a current- dues paying member of Indiana Dairy Producers or;
5. Be a current employee of a current dues paying member of Indiana Dairy Producers.
